1. Read **Hebrews 5:11-14**. Admittedly, the doctrine of the incarnation is a difficult one to understand, but how does this passage from Hebrews encourage us to consider these deeper matters even if we can't fully comprehend them? What are some resources we can use to pursue more "solid food" in order to mature in our faith?

2. Read **Isaiah 6:1-5**. Considering this is the same Jesus who "became flesh and dwelt among us," how does this passage help you appreciate even more the humility of the incarnation?

3. Read **Hebrews 2:17**. According to this verse how should we understand the humanity of Jesus in relation to our own (excepting the sin nature)? Why was it necessary for Jesus to possess a true human nature, like ours but without sin, in order to become our merciful and faithful High Priest (Hebrews 4:15)?

4. Read **Romans 11:33-35**. Do these verses encourage your pursuit of knowing Christ more or discourage you? Why? Even though we may never comprehend the mind of God or the full glory of God in this life (or the next), why is this still a worthwhile pursuit for every Christian?
