Discussion Questions

1. Read **1 Timothy 2:1-2**. What reason does Paul provide as to why we should be praying for our leaders? Is that *"peaceful and quiet life"* an end in and of itself or a means to a greater end?

2. Read **2 Timothy 3:1-5**; **4:3-4**. A friend from church comes to you discouraged by everything going on in the world right now, feeling hopeless about the future. They struggle to see the purpose of praying for revival when the Bible tells us things are going to get progressively worse. Are they right? Should we expect a revival still? If not, why not? If so, how would you encourage them revival is still possible, and we should be praying for it?

3. Read **Philippians 1:27-2:2**. We're not being imprisoned by Roman authorities or persecuted by the Jews, but what are some threats or dangers facing the church today? What role does unity play in combating these threats? How can we ensure that we are striving for that unity here at Compass?

4. Read **John 3:30**; **2 Corinthians 5:9**. Think about the various spheres of your life (work, home, recreation, social, church, etc.). What are some practical ways that we can make it our aim to please him in each of those areas? Where do you find this pursuit to be the easiest? Where is it the hardest?
