1. Read John 6:14-15 and Acts 1:6-8 . What situation are you currently facing where you would like to force God's timing to be your timing? What lessons has God been teaching you in the waiting?
2. Read John 6:19-21 and Mark 6:48-52 . In what ways are you tempted to forget what God is like as you go about your daily activities? What are some of the most encouraging aspects of God's character that bring you the most comfort and why?
3. Read John 6:24-25 and Matthew 7:21-23 . The people in John 6 didn't have a genuine desire for Jesus, and those in Matthew 7 don't have a genuine relationship with Jesus. What dangers of self-deception lurk in our culture, and how can you be sure that you're seeking Jesus for the right reasons grounded in a genuine relationship with him?
4. Read John 6:28-29 . The gospel is simple, and sometimes people simply choose to ignore its clear teaching. Other times, we can cloud the gospel through how we present it. What are some ways we run the risk of making the gospel unclear for someone we are evangelizing? What nonnegotiable elements must be abundantly clear in any gospel presentation?
