1. Read **John 8:15-18**, **Psalm 55:22**, and **Philippians 4:6-8**. What are some of the doubts you find yourself battling as a believer? What is the relationship between doubt and anxiety? How can Psalm 55:22 and Philippians 4:6-8 help us battle both?

2. Read **John 8:21-24**, **1 Thessalonians 5:23**, and **Hebrews 10:14**. As Christians, how can we develop a Pharisaical mindset that loses sight of our daily need for God's grace? What does it mean that our obedience doesn't make us any more justified in God's sight?

3. Read **John 8:25-29**, **Psalm 37:4**, and **2 Timothy 4:8**. Psalm 37:4 says the Lord will give us the desires of our heart, but there is a qualification to that. How does delighting ourselves in the Lord guarantee that we will have the desires of our hearts fulfilled? How does this relate to what Paul writes in the second half of 2 Timothy 4:8?
