Discussion Questions

1. **John 10:25-26** highlights the Jews' unbelief despite witnessing Jesus' miracles. What are some reasons people today might still refuse to believe in Jesus, even with evidence of His works? How can we address these barriers in our evangelism efforts?

2. Read **Matthew 28:19-20**. Pastor PJ suggested that we may be held accountable for whether or not we shared the gospel with the lost in our lives (not whether or not they responded in faith). What have you done or what will you do to pursue your lost neighbors this summer? This is an opportunity to learn from others in the group what has been effective for them as well as to encourage them with what has worked for you.

3. Read **John 10:37-38**. Reflect on the example of patient perseverance in evangelism as illustrated in the sermon. How can we remain persistent in sharing the Gospel with those who are resistant, and what practical steps can we take to show Christ's love and truth in our interactions?
