Discussion Questions

1. Read **John 11:48** and **Luke 14:28-33**. Where do you find that you feel the cost of following Jesus most acutely? What are you trusting in to make the cost worth it in the end? How can we communicate that this cost is worth it as we share the gospel with the lost?

2. Read **Daniel 2:20-21** and **Isaiah 45:1-3**. How do passages like this challenge your outlook on the current political landscape we face in our nation? How should texts like these increase our faith in our sovereign God? How often are you praying for your leaders and how might passages like these and the one from Habakkuk referenced in the sermon inform the way we pray for and about our leaders?

3. Read **John 11:54** and **2 Timothy 4:6-8**. What are some reasons that you've encountered for believers who choose to move to the sidelines rather than staying on the field where God would have them? How do you feel that you're doing in this regard? Is there an area of your walk where you are tempted toward the sideline? What encouragement do you need to stay in the game?
