Discussion Questions

Community Groups meet throughout the week and play a crucial role in our response to the preaching of the word. These groups gather to discuss the following questions as we seek to apply the sermon in community with one another. Please visit compassntx.org to join a small group near you.

1. Read **Romans 12:9-13**, **Titus 2:1-8** and **Philippians 2:1-4**. How do passages like these point to the necessity of being a committed part of a local church? How can one apply these passages (written to believers about relating to other believers) when they aren't committed to a local church? How should you respond to the Christian who says they are part of the universal church, and they don't need to commit to a local church?

2. Read **1 Corinthians 12:11**. Have you ever considered what your spiritual gifting might be? How do you feel the Lord has gifted you for the edification of the body?

3. A friend comes to you and tells you that they took a spiritual gifts inventory test and identified that they have the gift of teaching. However, they don't see any open teaching positions at their church, so they're considering leaving the church to find another one where they can teach. With some added questioning, you find out that their current church is understaffed in kids ministry, and their usher team could really use some more men to help with the weekend services. What advice might you give this friend who is considering leaving because he doesn't see a role for him to use his gift of teaching?
