## Discussion Questions

*Community Groups meet throughout the week and play a crucial role in our response to the preaching of the word. These groups gather to discuss the following questions as we seek to apply the sermon in community with one another. Please visit [compassntx.org](http://compassntx.org) to join a small group near you.*

1. Read **2 Corinthians 5:20-21** and **Philippians 1:12-13**. How should someone balance tact/diplomacy in building relationships with the lost around them and the urgency we should feel in sharing the message of reconciliation with them? What is our worst-case scenario if we share the gospel “too soon”?

2. Read **2 Corinthians 5:20** and **2 Corinthians 6:1-2**. How important is it to call for a response when sharing the gospel? Why might this step be challenging, and how can we approach it with confidence?

3. Read **2 Corinthians 5:17-19**. What are some ways you have started gospel conversations that have proved effective? Can you share an example of a time someone responded in faith and repentance when you shared the gospel?

4. Review the Umbrella Method with your group. (You can watch a video of the Umbrella Method here: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KmKZJx5AIWY>.) Over the next month, we will have “quizzes” to train everyone in the group to use this method as one option for sharing the gospel.
