## **Discussion Questions**

Community Groups meet throughout the week and play a crucial role in our response to the preaching of the word. These groups gather to discuss the following questions as we seek to apply the sermon in community with one another. Please visit compassntx.org to join a small group near you.

1. Read <b>1 Corinthians 10:31</b> . What are the areas of your life where you find it hardest to seek God's glory over your own? In other words, what areas are you prone to self-reliance, or what areas of your life are you prone to boast in? What do we forfeit when we aren't consciously pursuing the glory of God in these areas?
2. Read <b>Romans 8:15</b> and <b>Hebrews 5:16</b> . How do we balance the intimacy and access we have to God with the idea of His glory (weightiness) that overwhelms anyone who ventures into His presence in an unworthy manner?
3. Read <b>Proverbs 16:9</b> and <b>Habakkuk 3:17-19</b> . Can you think of a time in your walk when God's plan was not only different from yours but also discouraged or frustrated you? What lessons did you learn during that season about glorifying God in spite of these challenges? How would you counsel another brother or sister if you knew they were about to enter a similar season?
4. Read <b>John 13:34</b> and <b>1 Corinthians 13:1-7</b> . What should sanctifying love (a love bent on another person's Christlikeness) look like amongst believers? In the church? At home?
