1. Read **Hebrews 10:23** and **Joshua 4:5-7**. One of the reasons we love baptisms is because we get to hear about what God has done in the lives of those being baptized. Spend some time as a group sharing some of the examples of God's faithfulness to you recently that have encouraged your trust in His promises.

2. Read **2 Corinthians 5:1-8** and **2 Timothy 4:5-8**. As Christians, looking to our eternal reward is such an important component of our ability to endure. But what are some of the glimpses of that future bliss that you experience presently? What are some examples of God's grace you experience here and now that allow you to keep fighting the good fight? encountered?

3. Read **John 14:6** and **Matthew 11:28-30**. How should we understand Jesus' burden and yoke? How can staying faithful to Jesus be a light and easy burden rather than feeling like the crushing uncertainty created by a guilt-induced mentality that measures security by obedience?

4. Read **John 14:6**. Why do you think the doctrine of the exclusivity of Christ is so unpopular among unbelievers? What are some ways we can helpfully explain why this is good news to the person who objects?
