## Discussion Questions

These groups gather to discuss the following questions as we seek to apply the sermon in community with one another. 1. Read **Ephesians 5:18** and **Romans 8:9**. How is a person to be filled with the Spirit? How is this different from the general indwelling of the Spirit that is common to all Christians?

2. Read **John 14:15-16** and **1 Thessalonians 5:19**. What does it mean to quench the Spirit? How might a person know if they are in danger of this?

3. Read **John 14:17** and **Philippians 4:8**. How do these verses complement one another? We live in a culture where conspiracy theories lurk under every rock and hide in every corner and not all without cause. How should our concern for what is true govern our desire for truth and justice in a fallen and broken world in which we find ourselves?

4. Read **John 14:17**, **Romans 8:14**, and **Galatians 5:16**. In your experience as a follower of Jesus, how have you remained sensitive to the leading of the Spirit? This can be subjective, which makes it difficult, but give an example of a time in your life you clearly felt the leading of the Spirit and why you felt so confident in that?
