Discussion Questions

1. Read **John 14:27**. What are some of the ways the world offers us peace? How is the peace that Jesus offers you different?

2. Many of us feel relief, and perhaps even peace, over the results of the recent elections. Would you say this is a worldly peace or a peace from God? How do you know?

3. Read **John 14:28** and **Hebrews 4:14-16**. At Compass, we say we have a genuine reliance upon prayer. How does Jesus's return to the Father impact our prayer lives?

4. What are some of the biggest obstacles you face in developing a consistent prayer life?

5. Think back to the Old Testament and all the Israelites had to go through to gain access to Yahweh, and that only through the mediation of a priest. How should these thoughts ignite a passion for us to pray more in light of the privilege we have in Christ?

6. Read **John 14:30**. If Satan had won, and Jesus had lost, what are some things that would be different about your life today? What response does that draw from you?

7. Part of our vision at Compass is to be a church that exalts Christ. Spend some time doing that as a group by praying and thanking God for the victory Jesus won on your behalf.
