| 1. Read John 16:7 and Ephesians 3:16-17 . You've probably heard people talk about inviting Jesus into their hearts. While that may not be the best way for us to speak of what it means for a person to be saved, in what way does Christ reside within us, even though he is seated at the Father's right hand? |

| 2. Read John 16:7 , Romans 8:13-14 , Romans 8:15 , Romans 12:1 , 1 Corinthians 2:14 , and Ephesians 1:13-14 . How do these passages illuminate the role of the Spirit in the life of a Christian? Why do you believe the Spirit is frequently overlooked or downplayed in our circles? |
| 3. Read John 16:8-11 . What is the Spirit's role in our evangelism? In what ways might we be tempted to bypass this essential aspect of the Spirit's ministry? |
| 4. Reflect on your understanding of the Holy Spirit before hearing this sermon and studying this text. How did you perceive him? How would you have described your relationship with him? How has this sermon and these texts enhanced or transformed your understanding of the Spirit's role in your life? |
