## **Discussion Questions**

1. Read <b>John 17:11</b> and <b>1 Peter 1:22-25</b> . Using these texts, why is your godliness a necessary component of our church's well-being? How does this speak to the importance of getting connected in a local church?
2. Read <b>John 17:12-17</b> and <b>2 Timothy 1:12</b> . How should we process or think about the difference between our circumstances and those of the Syrian Christians being killed for their faith? If the answer isn't that we should feel guilty, what should we take away from the stark contrast between our two realities?
3. Read <b>John 17:18-19</b> and <b>Colossians 1:24-26</b> . What is your plan to engage your family, neighborhood, and coworkers during the weeks we have in front of us leading up to Easter?
4. The sermon covered three crucial pursuits for the Christian, but these are certainly not the only three crucial pursuits for a follower of Jesus. What are some other "bare necessities" of our Christian walk?
