## Application Questions

These groups gather to discuss the following questions as we seek to apply the sermon in community with one another. 1. Read **Romans 12:17-21**. What makes it so hard for us to let go of our own desire for payback? How does knowing that God's holy character guarantees perfect justice free you to respond with kindness instead of anger?

2. Read **Colossians 2:13-14**. How does it challenge you to realize that this forgiveness applies even to the person you find hardest to forgive—if they belong to Christ? Why is that difficult? How might this passage reshape your prayers for those who've wronged you?

3. Read **Romans 9:22-24**. According to this passage, what impact will seeing God's wrath have on those who've received His mercy? How does knowing about God's eternal justice both comfort us in our own experiences of injustice, and also stir compassion (or fear) for those who've wronged us?

4. If you're willing, share an injustice you have experienced that you have found it difficult to roll over to the Lord. Then let's pray together for these situations and for us to find solace in God's just and holy character.
