## Application Questions

1. Read **Philippians 2:3-4**. Why do you think it's often easier to serve strangers or acquaintances in a selfless and sacrificial manner than it is to serve those closest to us in the same way?

2. Read **Philippians 2:5-7** and **Hebrews 2:14-18**. How does the incarnation and the depths to which Christ condescended to identify with us nullify the excuses we might come up with as to why we can't or won't serve those closest to us?

3. Read **Philippians 2:8** and **1 John 4:10-11**. What might a heart that does not serve others out of love for them reveal about the eternal state of that person? Why is our heart attitude toward serving others such a good litmus test for whether or not we are in Christ?

4. Read **Philippians 2:9-10** and **1 Corinthians 9:24**. How is your humble and sacrificial love for others a part of running so as to obtain the prize?

5. Keep working on memorizing **Luke 2:10-11!**
